**Lyndhurst Mansion
and holiday luncheon**

On Monday, December 11, 2023



New York's Hudson Valley is home to many historic sites. Today we will visit the majestic estate of Lyndhurst Manor in Tarrytown, decorated in special holiday finery with special collections brought out for the season. Meet the coach bus at TNH Tully Park in New Hyde Park at 8:15 am and return by 6 pm.

We begin our day at Lyndhurst Mansion, one of America's finest examples of Gothic Revival mansions, in Tarrytown on the Hudson River. Designed by Alexander Jackson Davis in 1838, its architectural history was shaped by the three families that owned the home, the Pauldings, the Merritts, and the Goulds. The main house evolved from a country villa to a Gothic mansion, surrounded by park-like grounds befitting a proper country estate of a wealthy family. Known for its rich furnishings and decorative arts, special collections are taken from storage for the different holiday displays each year. The 19th century in America was characterized by the Romantic movement in art, painting and architecture and emphasized the appreciation of nature, imagination and emotion, and the Hudson Valley became the center for artists of the period. Wealthy families commissioned the construction of mansions along the bluffs of the river, from New York City north to Albany. Lyndhurst sits on a 67-acre park along the Hudson River, a half mile south of the Tappan Zee/Mario Cuomo Bridge in Tarrytown. It is listed as a National Historic Landmark.

After our guided tour, we will proceed to the RiverMarket Bar and Kitchen for our holiday luncheon. After lunch, we head back home.
