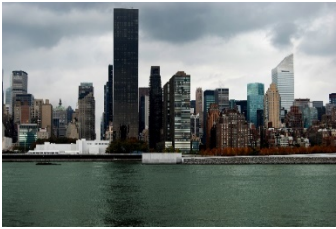
## Sunday Seminars on Long Island and New York History
