


WELCOME to Clark Botanic Garden

Founded in 1969, Clark Botanic Garden (CBG) is a 12-acre living museum and educational facility dedicated to understanding and appreciating the world's plant life through horticulture, education and research.

Among the numerous plant collections at CBG are native spring wildflowers, wetland, rock and rain garden plantings, hydrangeas, pines and conifers, bearded irises, lilacs, hollies, hostas, daylily and dahlia display gardens, a tropical garden, butterfly plants, sensory herb garden, medicinal plants, rain garden plants and over a dozen collections of particular plant families.

CBG was a recent award-winner in the All-America Selections (AAS) 2018 Landscape Design Challenge and is also listed as an official Daylily Garden by the American Hemerocallis Society.
