Join us as we visit Sunnyside, the home of Washington Irving, in the historic Hudson Valley town of Sleepy Hollow. Decked in holiday splendor for the first time, we will have a guided tour of the charming cottage where the famed author resided.

Listed on: U.S. Register of Historic Places, U.S. National Historic Landmark, NYS Registry of Historic Places.

The Architect: George Harvey

The Styles: Dutch Colonial Revival, Scottish Gothic, Tudor Revival and Romantic. The cottage-like estate, featuring a wisteria-covered entrance and jagged crow-stepped gable became a national historic landmark in 1962. Built on ten acres along the Hudson River, it was sold to John D. Rockefeller in 1945 in his efforts at historic preservation.

We will also have the opportunity to visit the Union Church of Pocantico Hills, which was built by J. D. Rockefeller in 1921 in the Gothic Revival Style. The beautiful church is adorned with the magnificent Chagall and Matisse stained glass windows.

For our holiday luncheon, we will return to last season's wonderful venue, the River Market Bar and Kitchen, in nearby Tarrytown. After lunch, we head back home.
