Lessons are aligned with the New York State Science Learning Standards

Life Science 1.A: Structure and Function - All organisms have external parts. Different animals use their body parts in different ways to see, hear, grasp objects, protect themselves, move from place to place, and seek, find, and take in food, water, and air. *Plants also have different parts (roots, stems, leaves, flowers, fruits) that help them survive and grow.* 

All students will bring a bagged lunch. The teacher along with 2 or more chaperones must accompany the students. Facilities are limited and children may need assistance with the take home project.
